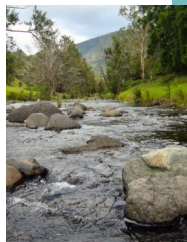


Enjoy the pristine waters of Christmas Creek—paddling, swimming, rock-hopping, fishing or just plain lazing about...
